L9 Scoring Coordinator Duties- 2025

You should receive the tee sheet of players from the club by Tuesday. The tee sheet will note the Golf Genius codes that are needed to access the leaderboard after play has concluded. If you did not sign up to play, you may not receive the sheet, contact the President or Games Coordinator to get it. Ask the Check in coordinator for that day to send/text the filled-out sheet to you to help figure out who played. Please print out a copy of the Blank Winner Template Sheet and bring it with you the day of play.

You will need to determine winners for that day's event:

- Team games have two winners- first and second place.
- Individual games have three winners- first, second and third place.

At present we usually have enough players to have one flight from Course, one or two each from Island and one or two each from Skidaway. (Unless it's a Skidaway Scramble, then everyone is Skidaway.) The Winner Template contains areas for more flights in case of a larger field. When there is a small number of players assigned to multiple tee boxes, group them in one flight (ie. when there are only 3-4 players on each tee).

Golf Genius Leaderboard:

The software takes care of handicaps and when programmed correctly it scores the games including tiebreakers. You simply need to transfer the information from the Golf Genius leaderboard to the Winners Sheet Template that you printed out and brought with you. To log into Golf Genius to see the day's scores, use any code from the tee sheet and log in on your phone. You do not need to be a player to access GG as you can log in as any individual using the codes from the tee sheet.

IF you receive a single scorecard from a late add, you will need to hand score. For individual games it is straightforward- simply check the math and score according to the game played and compare that score to the rest of the GG leaderboard.

IF a person is added to a team and is not in Golf Genius, you will need to check the score by hand for that team's scorecard. The team may be in Golf Genius BUT the added person may not be included. THEREFORE, ignore the Golf Genius score of the team. Compare the hand score of the "new" team to the scores within the leaderboard.

In the event of a tie score, identify winners by comparing scores starting with the most difficult hole. Eliminate high scores and if a tie still exists, select the next most difficult hole and compare again (would be 2nd tiebreaker). Identify the winner by adding "tiebreaker" after their name(s). Example at the end of this file is an old winner sheet of Par 3s and 5s showing tiebreakers.

Blind Draw- if a group only has 3 players in a 4-person team game, you need to add a blind draw. As scoring coordinator you perform the draw. Use the tee sheet for all players from that group's tee box. Then select your favorite number and the person with that corresponding number on the tee sheet becomes the blind draw for the first scorecard that needs one. Repeat as needed with for other tee boxes. Hand score the team with the new player as above. Enter the selected player's name on the winner sheet if that team was a winner with "blind draw" after her name.

When you are back home and at your computer, you will have to enter the information about winners onto a digital version of the Winner Template.

(EXAMPLES BELOW)

The file on the third page is an example of a Winner Template filled out after an event, and the fourth page is a blank template for you to copy and use. It's created with text boxes. Simply save this four-page file again, but delete the first three text pages and edit the Winner Template form and insert the necessary information. Save your edited form as a PDF labeled L9 winners and date of play, i.e. "L9WinnersDecember12". The form should be completed by Thursday afternoon and sent as a pdf to 5 addresses: President Mary Ryan (mbr5172@gmail.com), Games Coordinator Jane Golz (golzjane@gmail.com), Pointskeeper Marianne Gardner (fastco44@ix.netcom.com), Publicity Marleen Castellan (castellan.marleen@gmail.com) and the TWATL (TWATL@comcast.net).

If you do not have access to a computer, you may need to do it by hand, bring a hard copy of the winner sheet with you on Thursday so you can write the winners legibly on the sheet and take a photo of the completed form and email to Jane. Do not send photos to the TWATL, it needs to be typed first.

Doing scoring after L9 play days takes about an hour. Sometimes it's helpful to get someone to work with you as a second pair of eyes. Also, it's best to fill out the scoring form at the clubhouse so you can ask people questions if their scores don't make sense. Afterwards take it home to type up and send email. Otherwise, the handwritten form needs to be very clear and legible for everyone to be able to read it.
